Grants for environmental or humanitarian/community projects

Green Door Group is offering grants to support new or existing environmental or humanitarian / community projects.

Grant pool

This call is for items or projects valued between \$200 to \$1000.

Who can apply?

- Community groups
- Incorporated Associations
- Not-for-profits
- Organisations
- Entities delivering environmental or humanitarian/community work

Location eligibility

The project must be delivered in:

- Scenic Rim Regional Council region and/or
- Logan City Council region and/or
- Gold Coast City Council region

The organisation may be located out of these areas (e.g. a national body). The project may be Queensland wide or national but your application must show how specific outcomes will be achieved in at least one of the locations listed above.

How to Apply

Applications should be submitted (**by post only**) on the Expression of Interest Form by **Friday 24 September 2010**. Successful applicants will be announced by 5 November 2009. Successful projects will need to be completed by the end of 2010 although it is expected that the benefits from the project will extend beyond this date.
